I. THOUSAND ISLANDS FRONTENAC BIOSPHERE RESERVE.

Louise introduced guest Don Ross. Some of his main points:

- A. Many organizations came together to make the project a reality. Eg: Canadian 1000 Islands Heritage Conservancy, Land Trust, Nature Conservancy.
- B. Some ways the Biosphere Project potentially can make a difference:
 - 1. Advise landowners of best conservation methods.
 - Networking improvement. Now 116 organizations in the Biosphere region.
 - 3. Township Planners might be influenced.
 - 4. Educate about the cultural and ecological diversity.
 - 5. Non-regulatory. A resource of information.
- C. Designation Process was swift, only 18 months vs usual 4-5 years, because:
 - Important Core Areas: St. Lawrence Islands National Park, Charleston Lake Provincial Park, Rideau Canal.
 - 2. Queen's University Biological Research Centre.
 - 3. Connects Frontenac Arch with Adirondack.
 - 4. Contains five Forest Regions.
 - 5. Biological Diversity is one of greatest in North America.
