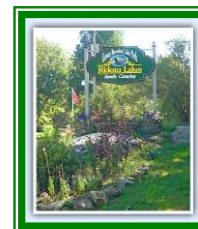

### **TEMPERANCE OR TEMPTATION? August 20**

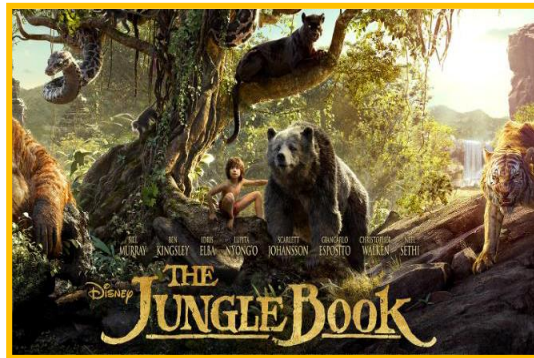

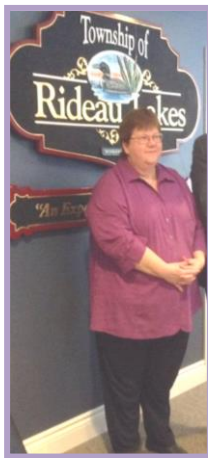

It is great that summer has finally arrived and with that, we welcome home all of our summer residents.

During the past few months, Council and Staff have been working hard to finalize details and to complete the following projects:

- ✓ The Delta Landfill Site has now been capped and we are now waiting for final approval from the Ministry of the Environment. The site will continue to be used as a transfer site.
- ✓ New energy efficient LED replacement streetlights will soon be installed.
- ✓ Road work is ongoing; the spreading of gravel and calcium has almost been completed. Short Point Rd is in the process of being reconstructed while the final surface treatment has been completed on Hartsgravel, Smith and Thousand Acre Roads.
- ✓ Changes to the layout of the Portland Landfill Site are ongoing.
- ✓ The quest to find a Coordinator for the Ward Structure Review has begun. Included in the review will be public meetings to receive input from the residents.
- ✓ The Economic Development Committee has been established and meetings have been held with the goal of reviewing our current business listings and cultural assets.
- ✓ The Municipal Heritage Advisory Committee is searching for a coordinator to plan a Doors Open program for Rideau Lakes Township and the Village of Westport during the fall of 2017. Please consider including your heritage property on the tour!
- ✓ The Delta Community Improvement Plan is still available; assistance may be available to help subsidize some of your improvement costs. Contact the Development Services Department at 613-928-2251 for more information.
