5. Water Quality	Dave Champagne's report of Water Quality for this summer has noted that the amount of oxygen in the water has altered. In 2012 it was "2", in 2018 it was "3" and this year it was only "1". This raises questions about the health of the lake.  Research has lead Dave C to have recommended the purchase of testing equipment that Holly (from CRCA) recommends. It was moved by Marsha and seconded by Lynne that the LBLA will cover costs up to \$3000.00 for the equipment not including HST	
	Concern was expressed that the Fire Department has been funding fireworks displays with funds donated from LBLA members.	Marsha will write a letter to accompany donations from LBLA members to the Fire Department specifying how
