Minutes

The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed and accepted.

Financial

A financial report was presented by Betty to each of us and Lynne noted that the budget is now shown on the back of the report. Currently we have 95 paid membership, with 11 Pay Pal and 9 others to process. There are currently 3 paid corporate members. Marsha suggested we could ask Levac Propane to become a corporate member. She also suggested that we might check to see if any of our corporate members might want to sponsor an event we could have. At the Lyndhurst yard sale, two kind ladies, Jane Moreland and Vicki Duggins set up a donation jar for our Lake Association and collected a donation of \$184.00. Way to go, ladies!

Water Levels & Water Quality

Visually we can see that the water levels are still quite high. Dave has been unable to put his measuring equipment into the lake because of this. CRCA is talking about setting up a lending library of tools and equipment to be used by Lake Associations to test for additional data. Specifically, they are looking for dissolved oxygen, temperatures, PH levels etc.

Eastern Ontario Lake Association Networking Group

The April meeting of this group, attended by Lynne, was excellent and very informative. There were lots of speakers with various subjects of interest to us and our lake. This is a very large group of Eastern Ontario Lake Associations that meet twice per year.

- b. Ecottage films A cottager would get an email that their cottage had been filmed. The group is definitely not in favour of these films saying that they are working in conjunction with the various lake associations.
- c. Handy guide They had a good guide done by Bob and Crow Lakes which they have handed out to newcomers. We do a similar thing with our welcome packages and the website. It was decided not to create a similar document as it was quite long.

Rideau Lakes Networking Group

There have been no recent meetings and/or developments from this group.

Other Business

- Lynne gave us some data regarding the sending out of our newsletter. In 2016, we went out 173 paper copies and 120 electronic copies. In 2017, we sent out 133 paper copies and 152 electronic copies. This is a great savings in our mailing expense.
- After the AGM in July, Tom Heinze and Joe Kelly (from Whiskey Island) will be taking over their duties with Lynne acting as Past President.
- There was a CRCA event held last Sunday which was attended by Tom, Dave J and Lynne. They have fact sheets for each lake. Lynne will get some paper copies for viewing at the AGM. Lots of very good information can be found on their website. CRCA's area is much more rural than other conservation authorities so they don't have the same funding available as do the RVCA(Rideau Valley) and the MVCA (Mississippi Valley).
- It was noted that the Ontario Federation of Anglers has been surveying our lake for years to check for invasive species. (Note: that was misinformation Lynne received. Lynne will begin surveying for invasive species this year.)
