On Thursday <u>April 6<sup>th</sup>, 1905</u> an article in the <u>DELTA PILOT</u>. read "born in the thriving village of Delta, it is a bouncing babe, the idol of the community and has grown so rapidly that it is able to run at an enormous speed".

With the Reverend George Wellington Connors as the Editor-In-Chief, the <u>DELTA PILOT</u>. was distributed every Thursday between 1905 and 1908. The newspaper was printed in a King Street drive shed, which was opposite John Street, on a printing press that had been relocated from a defunct printing plant in Bancroft.

After 3 successful years, Rev. Connors wrote another article on <u>March 27<sup>th</sup>, 1908</u> stating *"this issue completes the publication of the Pilot in Delta*, thus ending an era of newspaper life in this community – that is until NOW!



200<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of St. Paul's Anglican Church



2011 will mark St. Paul's 200<sup>th</sup> year of service to the village of Delta and the surrounding community.

St. Paul's is one of the oldest continually used churches in Ontario. Construction of St. Paul's was initiated by the Baptist congregation in 1811 and completed with assistance from the Anglicans who eventually assumed ownership of the building. Both of these founding denominations shared the facility for a period with the Methodists (1843-1862). One could say that St. Paul's was the birthplace of ecumenical fellowship in our village.

Throughout the years, St. Paul's has been a focal place in our community, and not just for those who gather to worship on Sunday mornings. Whether it is the anxious groom waiting for his bride; the young parents with their infant waiting to be baptized; or the family being comforted by friends and loved ones, St. Paul's has, and continues to provide a warm and welcoming venue for community fellowship, where the Grace of God and the love of neighbours and friends have touched people's hearts and minds in profound and life-giving ways.

The first in a series of events planned for this year will take place Sunday April 3<sup>rd</sup> beginning at 9:00am when the congregations of the three churches in Delta will come together to share in a Service of Celebration at St. Paul's. The service will honour the three churches that shared the building at various points in time between opening in 1811 until 1864 when the Baptists sold their remaining shares.

Pastor Brian Wheaton, Reverend David Timpson, and Reverend Canon Karen Freake will jointly conduct the service. The general public is welcome to attend.
