#### News from the Lower Beverley Lake Association



The **Annual General Meeting** will be held on Saturday, July 13<sup>th</sup> in the Main Exhibit Hall at the Delta Fair Grounds. The morning will begin at 9:30 a.m. with social time followed by the meeting at 10:00 a.m. The guest speaker for the morning will be Mr. Gary Neilsen who is a Climate Change Project Coordinator with the Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources.

An "Endangered Species" presentation will be held on Saturday, July 20th.

Presented by the Lower Beverley Lake Association in conjunction with the Lower Beverley Lake Park, the event will be held at the Bradford Pavilion in the park starting at 10:00 a.m. Tim Wood, species at risk specialist, will explain everything you need to know about local species at risk. His talk will address the factors affecting these species and what is being done to protect them. Tim will dispel some myths, deepen your appreciation for such species at risk as the Gray Rat Snake, and educate you about the value and role of these species in the ecosystem. Tim might even bring some live specimens for you to get up close and personal! Tim Woods is a species at risk technician with the Ministry of Natural Resources in Kemptville.


