Hall. Refreshments will be served at 6:30 p.m. The guest speaker for the evening will be Michael Runtz and his topic will be Dam Builders: The Natural History of Beavers and their Ponds. He is one of Canada's most highly respected naturalists, nature photographers, and natural history authors. A birdwatcher since the age of five, he has lived, breathed and worked with nature all his life. Professionally, Michael has worked as a naturalist in Canada's national and provincial parks, and has performed numerous biological surveys, including one on the rare Peregrine Falcon.Members of the general public are welcome to attend.

Bud Andress at the Bradford Pavilion in Lower Beverley Lake Park on July 18<sup>th</sup> at 11:00 a.m. The presentation will provide details about the complete recovery of the osprey population and the fact that the bald eagle continues to recover on both stories from the 1000 Islands. Inland residents on Upper and Lower Beverley Lakes will be able to appreciate the information provided whereas the same recovery has been taking place on 'the back lakes' for over 30 years following the DDT contaminant era of the 1940's through to the early 1970's. Many organizations and people have been involved in active habitat management and research of these species which has assisted the recovery process.

Volunteers are needed to participate in the annual **Clean the Lake** program which will be held on Thursday, August 6<sup>th</sup>. Volunteers are asked to meet at the Village Boat Launch at 10:00 a.m. A pizza lunch will be provided at the end of the session. Friday, August 7<sup>th</sup> has been set as the rain date.

Thanks to an ongoing partnership between the Lower Beverley Lake Park Management Board and the Delta Beautification Committee, a heritage plaque will soon be installed at the Mill Creek Drive entrance to the Delta Fair Grounds.

This plaque, which is designed to commemorate the 185<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Delta Agricultural Society, will be the seventh in a series of heritage displays in which photos and anecdotes of Delta's history are showcased.

A vote of thanks is extended to all of the volunteers who

helped in painting the 2 gazebos, benches and the flower barrels and to those volunteers who helped plant the flowers. The municipal watering program for the flower pots in Delta provides a student to water the flowers every Wednesday and Friday. Assistance is needed in watering the flowers on the alternate days.

Future beautification plans include the enhancement of Stevens Park through the addition of benches, flowering shrubs and another heritage plaque which would honour Elder Abel Stevens, the first settler and founder of Delta.
